


# Wall Mounted Pot Rack

Note: Depending on length purchased, the pot rack will have 2, 3, or 4 wall brackets.



(overhead view)



### 1) Flat Bars

Attach flat bar to front of all brackets with hardware, as shown in *figure 1*. Hand-tighten cap nuts until all flat bars are installed.

### 2) Mounting

Square flat bars with wall brackets and tighten hardware. Mount to wall\*. Refer to *figure 2* for bracket mounting locations.
